The Behavior, Language, Education, Socialization, Cognition (CLESCO) Doctoral School has 56 PhDs who graduated in 2016, of which 36 responded to the survey

Three years after the defense, 92% of the PhDs have a job. This employment rate is similar to that observed for all PhDs, all EDs included.

They work mainly in the field of higher education and research (61%) and 24% teach outside higher education.

Two-thirds of them have a stable job (permanent contract or civil servant) mainly in the public sector (61%).

21% of them work abroad.

While most of them are satisfied with their professional situation (94%), 41% are dissatisfied with their salary level, which averages €2,186 per month.












